Function of the department & main purpose of the role:

To provide electrical services on the Studio Floor, to erect lighting as per the requirements of the Director of Photography or Lighting Camera in a safe and workable manner. To support, learn, and develop from working with the Gaffer and Electrical team.

Duties & Responsibilities:

- To become familiar with working processes and equipment whilst training under the supervision of the production Gaffer and wider electrical team.
- To track and monitor kit levels and maintenance requirements throughout the shoot and discuss with the Gaffer before shortages/ maintenance needs become an issue.
- To support other Electricians and provide electrical services as required by DOP / LC / Gaffers, including Practical work
- To undertake and record lighting diagrams
- To carry out maintenance as required
- To report any defective equipment and return to workshop
- To uphold housekeeping on sets being worked on.
- To ensure all duties allocated are carried out effectively and on time.
- To remain responsible for all activities across your units and ensure the accuracy of all work undertaken.
- To ensure that established processes and workflows are followed on all units under your supervision.
- To meet production goals and requirements, and to relay information to production as needed.
- To observe the provisions of the Health and Safety at Work Act and to ensure that H&S practices (equipment and procedures within the studios) meet the Company guidelines
